Chapel Hill Children's School offers a Transitional Kindergarten class for 5-year-olds. This class is led by a degreed teacher with a full-time assistant.

The Transitional Kindergarten (TK) program is designed for 5-year-olds who are not ready for kindergarten. The TK class emphasizes academic and social readiness, while giving the children time to develop and mature in preparation for a successful Kindergarten experience the following year.

## Curriculum

Curriculum is based on the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) and includes a combination of curriculum guides and workbooks from McGraw Hill, Super Kids and Rowland Reading Program. Our curriculum includes:

**Language Arts:** The Language Arts curriculum includes reading with leveled and phonetic readers, emergent readers with repetitive and predictable text which also incorporates sight words and simple phonics, writing, journaling, listening and speaking.

**Mathematics** – Our mathematics curriculum incorporates hands-on activities using manipulatives. The curriculum covers 2D shapes, numbers 1-20 (all aspects, written seen, ten frames, subitizing), positional words, patterns, graphing, +/- story problems and fluency in kinder math.

Beyond our emphasis on Language Arts and Mathematics, we offer a curriculum which includes:

**Chapel** – Weekly chapel time includes songs and Bible stories that are relevant to each child's daily walk with Jesus Christ.

**Science** – The science curriculum is designed to teach children about the physical world and develop scientific methods of questioning, forming ideas, making observations and drawing conclusions.

**Music Appreciation** – Students experience creative movement through action songs and singing games. They express the enjoyment and love of music through singing and playing instruments.

**Technology** – Students utilize iPads to reinforce curriculum.

## ADMISSION PROCESS

- All children entering TK must be 5 years old on September 1.
- Chapel Hill Children's School current students will register in mid-February.
- Registration / supply fee and last month's tuition is due at time of enrollment. Registration / supply fee is non-refundable.
- Initial enrollment each year will be as follows: presently enrolled students who are church members, presently enrolled students who are nonmembers, church members, then open enrollment. Enrollment dates will be determined by the Director.
